



This exciting and unique event will run from Friday 3rd December 2021 until Sunday 2nd January 2022, however, the event is closed on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. It will be heavily promoted across numerous local, regional and national media outlets in the run up to opening and we anticipate in excess of 10,000 people to visit over the month, given its unique offerings.

In addition to craft stalls and food vendors, there will be a beverage tent, a performance stage for music and drama a 36 metre LED Ferris Wheel, family fun fair rides and a Christmas trail and Santa's grotto. Opening times are expected to run from Monday to Thursday 5-9pm, Friday 5-11pm and Saturday and Sunday 11am-11pm. Santa's grotto will be open until 9pm each day up until the 23rd December.

We would ask that you PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY and complete and return the application form in full. We anticipate a large volume of applications and any omitted information, may delay your application.

It should also be noted that The Omagh Winter Wonderland committee reserve the right to decline applications from applicants if it is deemed that they are not appropriate for the event or another vendor has secured a stall selling similar products.

CHRISTMAS MARKET STALLS

All wooden market stalls are provided with electricity (subject to fair usage). These are suitable for crafts or food.

FOOD VENDORS

Food Vendors with their own vehicle will be given a pitch space and a basic level of electricity.

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Important Information and additional requirements:

- Traders are responsible for the health and safety of themselves and their staff on site and should provide accident and incident report forms to the event coordinator should they occur on site.
- Traders must provide a waste bin for their customers and all waste must be taken away.

- Traders Must hold Current Public/Products Liability Insurance with and Indemnity Limit of no less than £ 2,000,000 (rising to £ 5,000,000 in some cases).
- Stalls are booked as presented by the Omagh Winter Wonderland. However, stall holders are welcome to decorate and dress as they see fit to promote their brand/products but must not cause any damage to the structure.

BOOKING PAYMENT

When you receive confirmation of acceptance by email, you will be required to pay 50% of the cost of the stall within 7 Days. The remaining 50% must be paid by the 26th of November 2021.

Information regarding the event set-up, arrival times, facilities etc will be emailed at least a week before the event begins. (Please check junk mail regularly).

PLEASE ATTACH copies of your food hygiene training certificates, HACCAP plans and safe systems of work, public liability insurance, electrical and LPG gas safety certificates, food hygiene rating certificate, where applicable. Bookings cannot be confirmed without evidence of above.
